

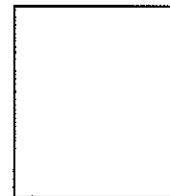
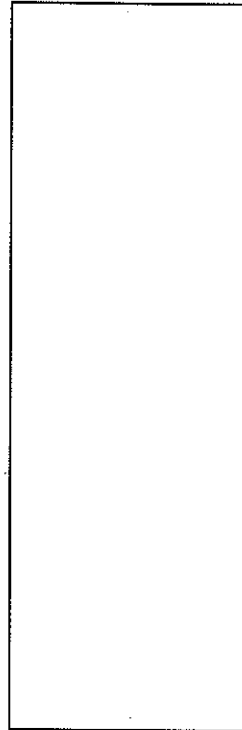
When and where are the meetings held? The meetings are held quarterly and are as follows

How does the Consumer and Family Advisory Board work?

What is the Consumer/Family Advisory Board Executive Committee (CFABEC)?

The CFABEC will consist of representatives chosen from each Judicial District in New Mexico by the CFAB members in six regions that comprise the state. It would be preferable to choose 1 consumer and 1 family member from each J.D. The CFABEC will meet periodically to discuss the information received from the regional CFAB.

How does a person become a member of the CFABEC? The CFABEC members will be chosen by the CFAB participants from members of the CFAB with representation from each of the Judicial Districts.
